





International Annual Event



World IoT Awards

In order to drive the development of IoT and digital economy, promote the progress of world economy and society, help to deliver benefits to people in terms of life and work, and contribute to the achievement of the UN Sustainable Development Goals and the building of a community of shared future for mankind, the World Internet of Things Convention (WIOTC) therefore establishes the World IoT Awards to encourage and commend enterprises, government institutions and organizations from all over the world which have made and are making contributions to the innovative development of IoT and digital economy across the globe.

Having been held for four years in a row, World IoT Awards include such awards as "WORLD IOT SPECIAL CONTRIBUTION AWARD", "WORLD IOT PROMOTION AWARD", "WORLD IOT LEADING PERSON AWARD", "WORLD IOT OUTSTANDING PERSON OF THE YEAR AWARD", "WORLD IOT LEADING ENTERPRISE AWARD" and "WORLD IOT INNOVATION PROJECT AWARD".

The WIOTA application is usually launched between July and September. The Awards will be announced to the world at the World Internet of Things Convention (annual conference) while the awarding ceremony will be held for award winners at the same time.



Category-Person: open to global renowned academicians, experts, and scholars; leaders from international organizations, government agencies and business associations; chairmen, presidents, CEOs, general managers from enterprises associated with IoT digital economy and technology.



Category-Enterprise: open to all enterprises related to IoT digital economy and technology.



Category-Project: open to all cutting-edge and innovative outcomes, products, technologies and solutions.

Exclusive Events-World IoT Awards

Special Enterprise Session

The session is targeted at IoT digital and high-tech companies. Here they can speak, share views on or release their products, technologies, solutions. At the same time, academicians and experts will join the session to share their report; companies can introduce the situation of frontier technologies. The session can be hosted or co-organized by companies.

Duration: one to four hours

Scale: 200 to 500 participants

For example, Forum on the innovative application of big language module in smart home organized by Haier Smart Home;



Industrial/Thematic Forum

The industrial/ thematic forum is conference sub brand of WIOTC focusing upon the fields of industry, agriculture, energy, AI, Auto Intelligence, transportation, logistics, culture , tourism, healthcare, smart life, finance, etc. The forum can be hosted or co-organized by industrial associations or companies.

Duration: Between half day and one day

Scale: 100 to 200 participants

For example, Industrial IoT Forum, AI Forum, Transportation and Auto Intelligence Forum.



Exclusive Events-World IoT Awards

Investment Promotion Forum (by local government/ high-tech and industrial parks management agency)

The investment promotion session or roadshow is an event centering on business or investment attraction as well as implementation of projects, which can be organized by local governments, economic development zones, and industrial parks.

Duration: two to four hours

Scale: 200 to 500 participants

For example: Sichuan Yingshan (Beijing) Investment Forum



Business Promotion Roadshow

The business promotion roadshow is an event of promoting the organizer's events and exhibitions, at WIOTC's important events. The organizers of famous event and exhibition can apply for hold the roadshow at our important events..

Duration: between one hour and three hours

Scale: 100 to 200 participants

For example, WAIC Circle Beijing.

Global Participation




Review of Past Events-Annual Convention
